
# **Prescot Primary School and Nursery**



## After School and Breakfast Club Provision

At Prescot Primary School we are proud to be able to offer our children (and parents/carers) daily After School and/or Breakfast Club provision, in a safe and secure place where children can play, learn, grow and build relationships.

Both of our clubs are very popular and children tell us they love coming to them. It's a place where our committed staff get to share a unique learning journey with children that is fun, exciting and varied. Our clubs are fully resourced and meet the differing needs of all children from across the school

#### Early Birds BC is for Reception - Y6 children Busy Bees BC is for Nursery children

#### Night owls ASC is for Reception - Y6 children Busy Bees ASC is for Nursery children

We have great relationships with our parents and communicate with them regularly through X (formerly Twitter), enabling them to share children's personal experiences in the club. Parents tell us that the clubs enable them to leave their children in an environment where they feel safe, respected, stimulated and above all happy.

Information below briefly outlines the details of each club, but we highly recommend that you come for a visit and see our provision for yourself and meet the staff.

We accept direct card payments, college or university childcare costs, Tax Free Childcare payments and Employers Childcare Vouchers for all of our clubs - please ask for details.

### Early Birds (BC) = Reception to Y6 from 7.30 am @ £4 per session.

#### Busy Bees (BC) = Nursery Children from 7:30 am @ £5 per session.

#### Please ensure you book the correct age related club.

Our 4 permanent members of staff **open the Breakfast Club at 7:30am each day** and offer children a variety of cereals, toast and jams together with a choice of milk, water or juice to drink. A choice of fruit is also available and is plentiful. After eating, children choose to play with a wide variety of toys available in the club such as lego, building blocks, dolls and craft activities. Resources are rotated daily to engage all children throughout the week. When school begins, younger children are escorted from the club directly to class, whilst the older children are accompanied to class by staff at 8:40 ready for the school day.

All Breakfast Clubs can be paid weekly/half termly via the school Arbor App. All sessions must be booked and paid for <u>a week in advance at the time of booking</u>. Details of how to book and pay will be emailed directly to you when required.

#### Night Owls (ASC) = Reception - Y6 children until 5:30pm @ £8.50 per session.

#### Busy Bees (ASC) = Nursery Children only until 5:30pm @ £10 per session.

#### Please ensure you book the correct age related club.

Children arrive at the After School Club from 3.15pm. Our younger children are escorted directly to the club by staff from their classes, whereas older children are guided by their class teachers. As children arrive they are encouraged to hang up their own coats and bags and wash their hands ready for snack. Thereafter, they choose their snack which has been prepared by the School Catering Staff in accordance with the Healthy Schools Directive. Choices consist of hot and cold foods such as wraps, sandwiches, bagels, paninis, pasta, soup, fruit, yoghurts, salads and even occasionally healthy cake! After snack, children can use the continuous provision of resources available both inside and outside (weather permitting). Our 4 members of qualified staff with paediatric or first aid training supervise the children during their play and plan activities that are seasonal and of interest to the children. The range of equipment and resources available offer children physical, creative, imaginative and exploratory play experiences designed to engage their enquiring minds. Quiet areas are also available for children who like to read, need peace or even take a nap! During each club we ensure that all dietary, religious and medical needs are adhered to together with any particular educational, social or emotional need of the children in our care.

# All After School Clubs: Collection is before 5:30pm and can be <u>paid and booked a week/half term in</u> <u>advance.</u>

We are always happy to discuss your requirements and our flexible system of booking allows you to be in control of what you need and when. On the odd occasion that you require additional (emergency) cover, you can contact the Manager to request additional sessions.

The ethos of the clubs echo those of the school and our enthusiastic staff take great pride in everything they do and are passionate about extending children's experiences outside the school day. We believe this philosophy and partnerships with parents are what helps us to stand out from other local providers.
